Winemaking : Very slow start of fermentation with low temperature. Short maceration on the fruit, taking care of the aromatic potential and keeping the silky tannins.

Tasting

Appearance : Red naughty robe.

Nose : Very aromatic nose with fragrances of little red berries salad (black currant, redcurrant and strawberry).

Palate : The mouth is full and sensual, with a powerful final.

Serving

Serving temperature : Between 15° and 18°.

Aging potential : 2 years.
